

Richard Flexer May 7, 1951 – November 29, 2021

Richard John "Rick" Flexer, of Perkasie and formerly of Coopersburg, PA, passed away Monday, November 29, 2021, at St. Luke's Hospice House, Bethlehem, PA. He was 70.

Born in Philadelphia, PA, he was the son of the late Melvin Sr. and Helen (Godleski) Flexer. A 1970 graduate of Lansdale Catholic High School, Lansdale, PA, he attained his Associate's Degree in Business from Bucks County Community College, Newtown, PA, in 1972.
